Featured Speakers



Kim Flottum has served as editor of *Bee Culture Magazine* for 33 years. After receiving a degree in horticulture from University of Wisconsin, Madison, Kim worked four years in the USDA Honey Bee Research Lab studying pollination ecology. After that, he spent 3 years farming fruits and vegetables in Connecticut, where bees played a large role. Kim has

served as Chairman of the Board of the Eastern Apiculture Society, President of the Connecticut State Beekeepers Association, President of the Ohio State Beekeepers Association, and President of the Medina County Beekeepers Association. In addition to writing and editing articles over the past 33 years for beekeepers, Kim has authored 5 books including: *The Backyard Beekeeper*, *The Backyard Beekeeper's Honey Handbook*, *The Beekeeper's Journal*, *In Business with Bees*, and *Better Beekeeping*.



Jon Zawislak is the apiculture specialist for the University of Arkansas Division of Agriculture. He has worked and played with honey bees since 1998, and is equally at home in the bee yard, the laboratory or the classroom. Each year he teaches workshops and short courses for new and experienced beekeepers throughout Arkansas and beyond. His teaching focuses on understanding the biology and behavior of bees

and their hive pests and keeping the bees healthy while minimizing the use of pesticides in the hives. He also spreads the word about the importance of pollinators to the non-beekeeping public. Jon has a background in botany and entomology and became an EAS Master Beekeeper in 2009. He and his family operate Walnut Valley Honey Company in Little Rock, Arkansas, producing good products from the hive, and supplying pollinators for area community gardens.
